In 2022, United Way partnered with the Dalton Housing Authority (DHA) to fully renovate a triplex housing unit for up to 18 residents. We are honored to continue the partnership with DHA. We will be fully renovating another triplex housing unit that should be completed by September. This will preserve affordable housing units in our local community and the renovations will increase the quality of life for the individuals and families who live in this low-income neighborhood.
