When Glenda's four children entered foster care in July 2024, everything changed.

After years of housing instability and the loss of their father, her family had already faced more than most. Losing her children was devastating—but it became a turning point.

Glenda made a decision: she would do whatever it took to bring them home.

With support from Family Support Council, a funded partner of United Way of Northwest Georgia, Glenda began rebuilding her life from the ground up. She secured stable housing and steady employment, committed to her mental health, and completed every class and requirement placed before her. It wasn't easy. But she never stopped.

Through it all, Glenda found her voice. In a system where stories can be overlooked, she advocated for herself and her family every step of the way. Her CASA volunteer stood beside her—listening, encouraging, and making sure her progress was seen.

Today, Glenda and her children are together again, building a new life filled with stability, hope, and a future that once felt out of reach.
